GUIDELINES for Retractable Awning Installation

- 1. Awning must be retractable. Standard, rigid awnings will not be approved.
- 2. Awning can only be attached to the rear of your home.
- 3. Awning cannot be attached to any fascia boards.
- 4. Awning attachment to home will vary depending on model of home. Adams model cannot accommodate an attached retractable awning.
- 5. Awning installer will provide ALCC install location.
- 6. Awning must be purchased with an aluminum cover.
- 7. Awning size and color must be approved by the ALCC.
- 8. Awning fabric must be woven acrylic.
- 9. Awning accessories are allowable and the homeowner's choice IE: motorized awning, dimming LED lights, patio lights, weather break panels, wind sensor, etc.
- 10.Acacia will not be responsible for any removal, repair, property damage, or maintenance to a retractable awning.
- 11.Retractable awnings must be approved by the ALCC before installation. Any awning installed without ALCC approval will incur a fine and may have to be removed at homeowner's expense.
