## **Acacia Balcony Guidelines**

- 1. Balcony project plans must be submitted to the Acacia A&L Committee for processing and approval, and if necessary, requester shall be referred to the Village for a building permit.
- 2. Reconstruction of existing balconies that have deteriorated or become structurally unsound necessitating the replacement of <u>structure supporting members</u>, or if more than fifty percent (50%) of a balcony is to be replaced, such construction must comply with all requirements of applicable Village codes and a building permit is required.
- 3. Removal, replacement or repair of Burnham and Dearborn balconies may require Village structural inspections and approval of interconnected bedroom floor joists before project completion.
- 4. Balconies to be refurbished must receive prior A&L Committee approval and comply with Indian Head Park Municipal Code Chapter 15.22, "Decks and Related Structures" which may require a Village Building permit prior to starting any construction, addition, removal, demolition or remodeling, especially when affecting structural integrity of adjacent building or connected structure.
- 5. Village ordinances require the Village Building Department be permitted to inspect the procedures being followed after a permit has been issued.
- 6. Use a competent and knowledgeable contractor to perform the work.
- 7. When a specific project has been satisfactorily completed, the \$250.00 security deposit held by Acacia will be returned to the owner.
